MASS ARRANGEMENTS FOR HOLIDAY PERIOD.

For all of July and a good part of August, for various reasons there will be only two priests available in the parish at weekends and often only one during the week.

There is a need therefore to introduce a temporary reduction in the number of weekend Masses from seven Masses to six. To accommodate this arrangement, it is planned to alternate Sunday Mass between St James and Feumore beginning this weekend, 1st July.

This means that this Sunday there will be no 9.00am Mass in St James, but Mass will be celebrated at 10.45am in Feumore as usual. Next Sunday 8th July, the 9.00am Mass in St James will be celebrated as usual but there be no 10.45am Mass in Feumore. This pattern of rotation of Masses will continue throughout the month of July. The arrangements for August will be reviewed later. Please check the Bulletin to confirm the details for the following week.


