We meet the excited, joy-filled mother who exclaims: 'My should proclaims the greatness of the Lord and my spirit exults in God my saviour'. We can almost feel Mary and Elizabeth dancing with excitement. Elizabeth's greeting 'Of all women you are the most blessed' marks the greatness of the moment. It also foreshadows Mary's future glorification. Wednesday's gospel reminds us of the early days of Mary's extraordinary journey; our mother Mary, who knew such human emotions as excitement, hope and a mother's love, and who understands our needs.
