Christian love

'God, that's very true' — a remark at our liturgy meeting after the second reading. Jealousy kills, envy too, and isn't it great to rejoice in the good fortune of another?

Love is what we bring with us at the end of life. 'We will be judged in the evening of life by love (St John of the Cross). Love for those near and far, for love in the gospel is more than love for just the family, the friend, the attractive one, the neighbour, for all.

There are different calls to Christian love - near and dear daily love, friendship, marriage, relationships. The wider world like in our job where we live in a loving way, in justice with all, not using others for personal gain; the wider world where a universal love makes me want to make a difference in the bigger world. Love carries us into wide seas and waters. It involves us with everyone. It obviously doesn't mean we relate to everyone - nor that we even like everyone. Love is when others' lives become at least as important as our own; and in the deepest loves like marriage, family, and often friendship, others' lives become even more important.

Love changes — we look back and see how the people we loved make the difference. Life is too short to look love in the face and say no.

'We are moulded and remoulded by those who have loved us, and though their love may pass, we are nevertheless their work' (F. Mauriac).

The second reading today is hard to beat! We see it in action when we look at the life of Jesus.



Pope Leo XIV born Robert Francis Prevost on September 14, 1955, in Chicago, Illinois, to Mildred (née Martínez) Prevost, and Louis Marius Prevost, a US Navy veteran of World War II. His father was born to immigrants from Italy and France. His mother was the daughter of Haiti born Joseph Martínez and Louise Baquiet from New Orleans. Pope Leo has two older brothers: Louis, a military veteran living in Florida, and John, a retired Catholic school principal.

Pope Leo's brother John noted that he aspired to the priesthood from a young age and in September 1977, he joined the Order of Saint Augustine as a novice and was Ordained a priest in Rome on June 19, 1982. Pope Leo joined the Augustinian mission in Peru from 1985, spending a decade heading the Augustinian seminary in Trujillo teaching canon law in the diocesan seminary, serving as prefect of studies, acting as a judge in the regional ecclesiastical court, and working in parish ministry on the city's outskirts.

On November 3, 2014, Pope Francis appointed Pope Leo as apostolic administrator of the Diocese of Chiclayo and titular bishop of Sufar. On September 26, 2015, he was named bishop of Chiclayo. In accordance with a diplomatic treaty, Pope Leo became a naturalized Peruvian citizen before becoming bishop. Within the Episcopal Conference of Peru, he served on the permanent council (2018–2020) and was elected president of its Commission for Education and Culture in 2019, also contributing to Caritas Peru. On September 30, 2023, he was created cardinal-deacon of Santa Monica degli Agostiniani in Rome.

On February 6, 2025, Pope Francis promoted him to cardinal-bishop, assigning him as titular bishop of the Suburbicarian Diocese of Albano. Pope Leo was elected Pope on May 8, 2025, at the 2025 papal conclave, thereby becoming the first American and Peruvian pontiff.

Pope Leo is a sports fan and an amateur tennis player. He is a fan of the Chicago White Sox of Major League Baseball. While living in Peru, he became a supporter of Alianza Lima, one of Peru's most prominent football clubs.
